Science

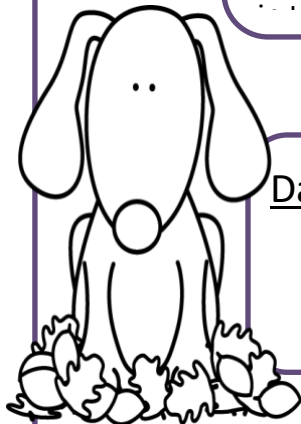
We have been working on inventors and the scientific method. The basis of most all physical science
